Raised in Wabush, Newfoundland and Labrador, Lloyd comes from humble beginnings, as the son of miners. His mother, Gloria, was one of the very first females to be hired at Wabush Mine, something he takes great pride in.

Upon graduating from high school, Lloyd enlisted and had a successful career in the Canadian Military as both a soldier and civilian that spanned 21 years. He served with the 2nd Battalion of the Royal Canadian Regiment and 103 Search and Rescue. Lloyd also spent time working as a recruiter with the military right here in Newfoundland and Labrador.

After his military career, he went on to have a very successful career in construction, and oil and gas with multiple companies that focused on civil construction, holding the positions of Operations and general manager.

Lloyd sat on multiple community boards and has been very involved in labor relations provincially, both in management and the union side, having served as:

- Vice President of a PSAC Local.
- Past member of the Executive Council on the Board of Directors for the Construction Labor Association in Newfoundland and Labrador.
- Served on the Board of Directors for the Hebron Project during its entire construction and sits as a Professional Management Trustee for a Health, Welfare, and Pension Fund.
- A volunteer on the Board of Directors of White Hills Ski Resort and is a former Town Councillor for the Town of Clarenville.

He has an extensive volunteer history with charities throughout the province, most notably Power to Hope and the Dr. H Bliss Murphy Cancer Care Foundation.

Lloyd was first elected to the House of Assembly as the Member for the District of Terra Nova on May 16th, 2019, and re-elected on March 27th, 2021.

During his time as the MHA for the District of Terra Nova, he has served in several high-profile shadow cabinet roles, including Tourism Culture Industry and Innovation, Transportation and Infrastructure, and Industry Energy and Technology. He has also been Caucus whip and served on several committees, including Public Accounts.
